1	Certification of assessed values to taxing districts	 The Assessor provided the following documents from a sample district (Cemetery #2 – Central Whidbey) that is representative of documents sent to all taxing districts in the county: Certification of assessed values for assessment year 2021 to the taxing district dated September 30, 2021 Certification of total taxable value, levy rate, and levy amount for 2021 assessment year for 2022 taxes levied dated January 11, 2022. The Assessor indicated State Assessed Utility Values were not certified to districts for the 2021 assessment year as required by the follow-up report the Department issued in May 2021. However, the Assessor indicated they plan on using a document from a another county who uses the same software vendor as a template going forward and plans to certify these values to taxing districts at least 12 days prior to November 30, 2022 after receipt of the State Assessed Utility Values.
