

## WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE LOCAL SALES TAX CHANGE

## City of Langley Transportation Benefit District Effective April 1, 2025

**Effective April 1, 2025**, the City of Langley Transportation Benefit District will impose an additional one-tenth of one percent (.001) for sales and use tax within the City of Langley. The tax will be used for transportation services.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the City of Langley (1502). Persons or businesses within the City of Langley will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new rate of sales tax is:

<sup>\*</sup>In addition to the .001 Transportation Benefit District tax, the City of Langley has imposed the Public Safety tax on April 1, 2025, for a total rate increase of .002.
